ABOUT THE BAND . . .

The concert band is comprised of 57 playing members and nine majorettes; 15 are Seniors, 21 are Juniors, 20 are Sophomores, and eight are Freshmen. This year 11 members were selected to participate in the Washington County Band and Chorus Festival. In the recently held Western District Band Festival at Waynesburg High School, Anne Swartz, Denny Franklin and Paul Lederstein had the honor of representing Fort Cherry. Paul Lederstein was selected to participate in the State Regional Band held in Uniontown. Eighteen members of the band have been selected for the National Honor Society. Bonnie Herriott participated in a Conducting Clinic held for one week at Duquesne University during the summer. Eight members of the Band have formed a Conducting Class which meets once a week. The Majorette Corps participated in two Majorette clinics held at Chartiers-Houston and Washington High Schools. Dolly Babeaux was the recipient of the D.A.R. Award. The Band has demonstrated its marching and playing ability extremely well in several parades, at all the half-time performances at football games, at the field house for the Basketball Play-offs, at the various school assemblies, and has successfully played two POP Concerts for both the Junior High and Senior High. Anne Swartz and Delilah Tornabene have made application to attend the West Virginia Fine Arts Camp to be held three weeks during the coming summer.
